

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year! Hope everyone had a great summer! Now that we are back to school I wanted to take a minute to advise of how to have a smooth and safe morning at drop off:

1. Safety Patrol will be at Orchard from 8:20-8:45 am to assist with getting children out of cars (



drop off line). Volunteers will be wearing a neon green/yellow safety vest

2. If you are using the drop off line (1st-5th grade only) please pull all of the way up and wait for someone to assist in getting the children out of the car

3. Please don't drop off by the kindergarten area or the front door. We want to keep the flow of traffic moving.. this tends to back it up.

4. If you are behind someone in the drop off line and they are taking some time.. please try to wait. When we go around the stopped car in line it can create a hazard..

5. Please be mindful of parents and children walking across the parking lot.. especially in the front of the drop off line

6. Please don't park or get out of your car in the line and children should not exit into the parking lot... they should be exiting on the passenger side of the car..

7. Please use the crosswalk

8. Please be aware of speed in the parking lot..

I know the mornings can be hectic.. thank you for your patience and look forward to a great year! Please keep in mind...We can always use volunteers for the line. The commitment is one time a month for 25 minutes... email me if you are interested.
